Design contemplates a white on white design; however, students may use other colors.

Student supplies the following: linen and threads in colors of their choice, as follows (or reasonable substitutes).

- Fabric: 13x18 inch piece of 28 count linen with an open weave, e.g., Irish or Cashel ®
 - Optional, a doodle cloth to practice
- Threads: *Select your fabric, then find the threads*, for instance, not all ‘white’ is white.
 - Flower thread such as Caron Wildflowers® or Dansk Blomstergarn® or Ginnie Thompson®. If going with a white scheme, you don’t need to purchase flower thread -- pattern purchase will include white flower thread .
 - #12 perle cotton – one ball,
 - #8 perle cotton – one ball,
 - Rayon such as Marlitt® or DMC rayon called “Satin” – one skein
 - Basting thread in medium color (not red or black)
- Other: Approximately
 - 85 beads, e.g., Mill Hill regular or #11 at a bead store
 - 5 genuine fresh water pearls or “rice” or “oat” beads that resemble pearls 2-3 mm wide
- Needles:
 - #26 tapestry
 - #24 tapestry
 - Beading needle such as #10 crewel, #10 straw or milliners or #10 or 11 quilting
- 13’x18’ inch stretcher bars and tacks

What the class teaches, (besides basic cross stitch and running/back stitches):

Starting and stopping when doing a pulled or

drawn design

Zigzag hem stitch

Ladder hem stitch

Four-sided stitch

Smryna cross

Diamond eyelet

Diamond hem stitch

Herringbone

Satin stitch,

Pulled Satin Stitch

Rhodes stitch

Faggoting

Twisted hem stitch

Bundled hemstitch

Pulled thread pin stitch

Queen stitch

Beaded flowers
